PROVIDE HYPERTENSION SCREENING FOR GRADE TEN  
STUDENTS**

Request For Proposals No. 041-EE10 – Provide Hypertension Screening For Grade Ten Students, opened on March 29, 2005, to provide hypertension-screening services to grade ten students attending Miami-Dade County Public Schools, for the Division of Student/Career Services, Comprehensive Health Services. Of 21 proposers sent proposal forms or card notices of this advertised proposal, 4 responded, with 1 non-responsive proposal and 3 no proposals. The University of Miami, Behavioral Medicine Research Program, was awarded the current contract and historically has responded to prior advertised solicitations and been the successful awardee on previous contracts. However, they declined to submit a response to this solicitation.

REVISED

On April 6, 2005, the selection committee met to evaluate the sole proposal received in response to the Request For Proposals: Medical Staffing Network. The committee determined that the proposal was non-responsive and recommended it be rejected. The recommendation reflects that the only proposal received be rejected to permit rebidding for the required services.
