REQUEST AUTHORIZATION FOR THE SUPERINTENDENT TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACTUAL AGREEMENT WITH THE EXCEPTIONAL DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION OF SOUTH FLORIDA TO PROVIDE EDUCATIONAL AND RELATED SERVICES FOR EXCEPTIONAL STUDENTS, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$390,502, EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2005, THROUGH JUNE 30, 2006

Authorization is requested for the Superintendent to enter into a contractual agreement with the Exceptional Development Corporation of South Florida to provide vocational training and employability skills training to individuals with disabilities. The agency will provide educational and related services in comprehensive on-the-job training programs for exceptional students, ages 18-22. Participation in these programs will provide students with an age-appropriate environment and the support necessary for making the transition from school to work upon leaving Miami-Dade County Public Schools. This facility is located at 991 NW 54 Street, Miami, Florida 33127. This contractual agreement has been in effect since 2003.

Funding for this contract will be provided, at least in part, by FTE generated from the Florida Education Finance Program (FEFP). Extended School Year (ESY) services, if required, will be provided through the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA). The proposed contract will provide services for a maximum of 40 students, in an amount not to exceed \$390,502, based on their current Individual Educational Plans (IEPs) and on their current matrix funding levels, effective July 1, 2005, through June 30, 2006.

The President of the Exceptional Development Corporation of South Florida is Mr. Michael Faine.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to enter into a contractual agreement with the Exceptional Development Corporation of South Florida, to provide educational and related services for a maximum of 40 exceptional students, in an amount not to exceed \$390,502, effective July 1, 2005, through June 30, 2006.
