**SUBJECT: REQUEST AUTHORIZATION TO ACCEPT A GRANT AWARD
FROM THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION (FLDOE)
FOR FUNDING UNDER THE TITLE IV COMMUNITY SERVICE
PROGRAM AT MIAMI DOUGLAS MACARTHUR SOUTH SENIOR
HIGH SCHOOL**

COMMITTEE: INSTRUCTIONAL EXCELLENCE & COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

Under the No Child Left Behind Act of 2001, the Florida Department of Education (FLDOE) Title IV Community Service Program awards grants to support participation in structured service programs for K-12 students who are suspended, expelled, or in alternative education programs in lieu of expulsion. This grant was awarded to Miami Douglas MacArthur South Senior High School to enhance and expand its existing service learning project.

Authorization is requested to accept a grant award from the FLDOE in the approximate amount of \$52,092 to fund the community service program at Miami Douglas MacArthur South Senior High School for the grant period of March 1, 2005, through August 31, 2005.

The program at Miami Douglas MacArthur South Senior High School involves students for approximately 30 hours per month in an off-campus "cottage industry" arts project within a community cultural arts facility known as ArtSouth. The students study under ArtSouth's resident artists, learning traditionally native art processes to culturally enrich the historic downtown district of the City of Homestead. Program participants design, construct, install and promote their own artwork that appears in fairs, exhibits, gallery shows, and festivals throughout the community.

An in-kind match is required to receive these funds. Community partners, including ArtSouth, R & S Gallery, Miami-Dade County Public Schools Exceptional Student Education Department, Citibank, and Mr. Stanley Levine & Associates, will cover the required in-kind match valued at \$17,191, by providing services such as marketing the *Art Talk Newsletter*, hosting the Miami-Dade County Art Show, transporting students to field trips and donating a variety of supplies. Funds in the amount of \$52,092 will be used for substitute salaries, hourly personnel, professional and technical services, travel, rental, supplies, furniture, fixtures and equipment, meals, and field trips. Indirect cost is not allowed.

Official notification of this grant award was received on April 19, 2005, which is after the start of the grant period. Reimbursement of grant-related expenditures is authorized effective March 1, 2005.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to:

1. accept a grant award from the Florida Department of Education (FLDOE) for funding the Title IV Community Service Program in the amount of \$52,092 for the grant period of March 1, 2005, through August 31, 2005;
2. extend this program and contractual agreement as authorized through official notification from the granting agency in order to complete the goals of the program; and
3. direct Financial Operations to establish appropriations in the amounts approved or as amended by the granting agency; such appropriations to be reported periodically to the Board.
