COMMITTEE: INSTRUCTIONAL EXCELLENCE & COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

The Ewing Marion Kauffman Foundation provides funds for the implementation and dissemination of entrepreneurship education instructional models in elementary and middle school classrooms. The goal is to form partnerships with outstanding school districts that have experience-based education and entrepreneurial leadership development as part of their vision for students.

School Choice and Parental Options developed and submitted a grant application to provide selected schools with the opportunity to experience entrepreneurship first-hand. This program will be incorporated as a unit in the 8th grade Social Studies classes in the School Improvement Zone schools. The following middle schools have been selected:

Brownsville Middle School
Campbell Drive Middle School
Charles R. Drew Middle Community School
Horace Mann Middle School
Jose de Diego Middle School
Madison Middle School
Miami Edison Middle School
Norland Middle School
Parkway Middle School
Westview Middle School

Grant funds in the amount of \$15,000 will be used for personnel stipends, part-time hourly, educational materials, and supplies to facilitate student development of portfolios and business plans.

Official notification of this grant award was received January 10, 2005, which is after the start of the grant period. Reimbursement of grant-related expenditures is authorized effective January 15, 2005.

3. direct Financial Operations to establish appropriations in the amounts approved or as amended by the granting agency; such appropriations to be reported periodically to the Board.
