SUBJECT: REJECT REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS NO. 043-EE10 – TEENAGE PARENT PROGRAM (TAPP) CHILDCARE SERVICES FOR CHILDREN WHO MEET LEGISLATIVE ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR THE 2005-2006 SCHOOL YEAR

The purpose of this Request For Proposals, opened on April 19, 2005, is to establish a contract, to provide quality childcare services for approximately 200 to 800 at-risk children, ages birth to 3 years old, who are children of pregnant or parenting students seeking a high school diploma, for the Office of District Regional Operations. Of 20 proposers sent proposal forms or card notices of this advertised proposal, 2 responded.

The Evaluation Committee met on May 24, 2005, and recommended that the proposals be rejected in order to change specifications to include geographical boundaries district-wide for these services, to better meet the needs of the District.

The existing contract has been extended through September 30, 2005, in order to provide continuity of services. The revised Request For Proposals will be awarded at the Board meeting of September 7, 2005, to be effective upon the expiration of the extended contract.

The recommendation reflects that all proposals be rejected to permit rebidding, using revised specifications.
