REQUEST FOR AUTHORIZATION TO ENTER INTO CONTRACTUAL AGREEMENTS WITH VARIOUS AGENCIES, FOR THE SERVICE OF SNACKS/MEALS FOR PARTICIPANTS HOUSED IN MIAMI-DADE COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOLS FACILITIES FROM AUGUST 19, 2005 THROUGH AUGUST 18, 2006

The Superintendent of Schools requests authorization to enter into contractual agreements with the following agencies for the Department of Food and Nutrition to provide snacks/meals for participants housed in Miami-Dade County Public Schools facilities:

- A. Centro Campesino
- B. Family Christian Association of America
- C. Jobs for Miami, Inc.
- D. The Liberty City Charter School
- E. Metropolitan Miami-Dade County Community Action Agency Head Start
- F. Amigos for Kids
- G. Young Women's Christian Association of Greater Miami (YWCA)
- H. Urgent, Inc. of Miami-Dade County
- I. United Cerebral Palsy Association of Miami, Inc.
- J. Health, Physical Education, Recreation, FIU
- K. Regis House, Inc.
- L. Youth Co-Op, Inc.
- M. One Art, Inc.
- N. Child Hope, Inc.

The above agencies sponsor after school programs or approved Charter Schools for Miami-Dade County Public Schools students. Staff from the approved agencies pick-up the requested number of snacks and/or meals daily from the school food service manager at the assigned school location. Agencies are billed \$0.65 per snack and \$0.60 per breakfast and \$1.25 per lunch per day. The Miami-Dade Community Action Agency, which administers Head Start Programs, is billed \$0.40 per snack per day, due to the smaller snack portion size for younger children (Pre-K 3 and 4). The school food service manager maintains daily billing records for the snacks and/or meals served to the approved agency and the School Food Service Accounting Department provides monthly billings to each agency for the total number of snacks and/or meals sold.

## **RECOMMENDED:**

That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent of Schools, to enter into contractual agreements with the various agencies, for the Department of Food and Nutrition, to provide snacks/meals for participants housed in Miami-Dade County Public Schools facilities from August 19, 2005 to August 18, 2006.
