Introduction

Staff has completed the selection process for one or more Architect/Engineers (A/E) to provide Architectural/Engineering services for several capital remodeling and renovation projects in the Facilities Work Program FY 03-04 (as may be amended).

Of thirty-five firms that applied, thirteen firms were short-listed. On September 20 and 21, 2004, the A/E Selection Committee interviewed and ranked the following thirteen firms:

Negotiations with the four highest-ranked firms were completed for other Facilities Work Program FY 03-04 projects, as described in the legal advertisement.

The firm of Brown + Brown Architects (BBA) was selected by staff to provide complete A/E services for the Structural Repairs project at Miami Senior High School, Project No. A01087.

Project Scope

The project includes, but is not limited to, field verification of repairs completed under previous projects; all required structural repairs at Buildings 1, 2 and 3.

Negotiations with BBA, for full Architectural/Engineering services have been successfully concluded as follows:

Terms & Conditions

The negotiated lump sum fee for basic services agreed to by BBA for preparation of design and construction documents, and subsequent construction administration is \$150,000. This fee represents approximately 5.3% of \$2,868,750, the current estimated construction cost.

A summary of the negotiated basic services fee is as follows:

Other Terms and Conditions

• The negotiated not-to-exceed lump sum fee for Board-designee's authorized Site

Visits is \$39,000 (or a maximum of 156 Site Visits at \$250/Visit);

- The Principals' rates are set at \$125/hour for the Architect, and \$125/hour for the Engineers, for Board designee's authorized additional services;
- The multiplier for hourly compensation is limited to 2.45 for any additional work approved by the Board designee;
- The A/E shall maintain no less than a \$2 million professional liability insurance policy with a maximum deductible of \$50,000;
- The Site Visits rate for any additional site visits authorized by the Board's designee is \$250/visit;
- The cost of printing will be reimbursed by the Board on a direct cost basis, per conditions stipulated by the A/E Agreement; and
- The Agreement provides for termination of the A/E by the Board, with or without cause, upon thirty days written notice to the A/E. The A/E may terminate the Agreement, only with cause, upon thirty days written notice to the Board.
- The A/E has accepted the terms and conditions of the Agreement.
