APPOINTMENTS AND LATERAL ASSIGNMENTS OF MANAGERIAL EXEMPT, PROFESSIONAL AND TECHNICAL PERSONNEL FOR 2005-2006

COMMITTEE: SCHOOL SUPPORT ACCOUNTABILITY

Authorization of the Board is requested to establish and classify new administrative position classifications in accordance with School Board Rule 6Gx13-<u>4D-1.022</u>, Manual of Procedures for Managerial Exempt Personnel (MEP), and the labor contract with the Dade County School Administrators' Association (DCSAA). The administrative assignment recommendations are made in accordance with Board Rules 6Gx13-<u>4A-1.16</u>, 6Gx13-<u>4A-1.161</u>, and the Miami-Dade County Public Schools/Dade County School Administrators' Association labor contract.

Considerations for reassignments of managerial exempt, professional and technical personnel were predicated upon an intensive review of information by appropriate administrators.

The recommended managerial exempt, professional and technical personnel appointments reflect the honoring of requests for lateral reassignments, where possible. Assignments of personnel and appointments of managerial exempt, professional and technical staff may be a result of the Board-approved advertisement and selection process, or by a direct appointment of an individual who has demonstrated the specific qualifications and background applicable to the position.

State Statutes and subsequent changes in Board rules governing Administrative/Professional and Technical Staffing require that all first year principalship appointments be "Interim" appointments.

In order to fill school-site allocations and other allocations vacated by promotion, leave, retirement, and other attritional factors, it is recommended that the following personnel assignments be authorized by the School Board. Revisions, additions and /or deletions may be made to the recommended personnel assignments, as necessary, to assure efficient school system operations, and if such modifications are made, a revised Board item will be submitted prior to the Board meeting.

Establish and classify the following MEP and DCSAA positions:

Leadership Development

Executive Director, Non-Instructional Training, MEP Pay Grade 22

Directs administration, development, design, delivery and implementation of training programs for non-instructional personnel and administrators to enhance job performance, customer satisfaction and provide career advancement.

<u>Professional Development</u>

Instructional Supervisor, Zones/STELLAR Support, MEP, Pay Grade 21

Supervises and monitors the development and delivery of professional development programs and opportunities to instructional employees in School Improvement Zone and STELLAR schools. Provides direct support to school-site teams and individuals. Has primary responsibility for coordinating the development of school-level professional development plans. Coordinates the provision of coaching and mentoring to instructional employees in School Improvement Zone and STELLAR schools.

Public Relations

Supervisor, Citizen Information, MEP, Pay Grade 20

Responsible for managing access to the District's public records. Requires interaction with all stakeholders of Miami-Dade County Public Schools to include senior level staff, parents, media, and business and community leaders.

School Choice and Parental Options

Director, Marketing and Special Events, DCSAA, Pay Grade 46

Responsible for the planning, organization, implementation and operation of major district-wide recruitment events and special projects and publications to market the school choice programs within Miami-Dade County Public Schools. Responsible for performing and overseeing technical and administrative work in the establishment, enhancement and support of web-based projects.

Facilities Planning

Manager II, Planning, DCSAA, Pay Grade 38

Assists in the planning activities of the department dealing with: local and state growth management and concurrency requirements; intergovernmental relations; land use/zoning issues impacting the District; and compliance with the provisions of the County Impact Fee Ordinance and Inter-local Agreement for School Facility Construction. Provides research, data gathering, analysis and report preparation. Performs other tasks relating to the development, implementation and management of inter-local agreements as required by growth management legislation.
