ENGAGEMENT

Miami-Dade County Public Schools (M-DCPS) is the fourth largest school district in the nation serving Pre-K through 12 and adult students. The District is committed to providing students with a top-notch education in a safe learning environment.

As with most large organizations, an official seal typically serves as the organization's distinctive and recognizable emblem, which reflects the organization's mission and purpose. Given the District's monumental role of equipping children and adults for lifelong learning and service, it is important that Miami-Dade County Public Schools adopt an official insignia to be used on all official documents and in all official business of the District. With the appropriate modifications, the current M-DCPS logo is a fitting insignia for the official seal of Miami-Dade County Public Schools.

That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, replace the existing Miami-Dade County Public Schools (M-DCPS) logo with a seal logo similar to the District's current pinwear to stand as the official seal of Miami-Dade County Public Schools
