SUBJECT: PROPOSED AMENDMENT OF SCHOOL BOARD RULE: 6Gx13-3E-1.10, TRANSPORTATION-SPECIFIC PROCEDURES

COMMITTEE: SCHOOL SUPPORT ACCOUNTABILITY

Current School Board Rules, specifically, Rule 6Gx13-3E-1.10, Transportation-Specific Procedures, which incorporates by reference the School Bus Transportation Rules and Policies Manual ("Manual"), allows students in Exceptional Student Education programs ("ESE students") to be transported to a different bus stop after school as compared to the morning drop-off location if the change in bus stop meets the criteria set forth in the Manual.

The requested change in this Board Rule would allow students who are not enrolled in the school district's ESE program to also benefit from these provisions if the different afternoon bus stop also meets the requirements set forth in the Manual. Additional criteria for a student to be permitted to have a different afternoon bus stop can include, but is not limited to: no additional cost to the school district; and the program where the student is being transported to must be approved by the School Board or by the school principal.

Accordingly it is requested that the School Bus Transportation Rules and Policies Manual incorporated in Rule 6Gx13-3E-1.10, Transportation-Specific Procedures, be amended to include the proposed changes described in this Item.
