On August 24, 2005, the Superintendent of Schools sent the following letter to Mr. Hansel B. Grant:

I am exercising my responsibility as Superintendent of Schools and recommending to The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, at its scheduled meeting of September 7, 2005, that the School Board suspend you without pay from your current position as Paraprofessional at Robert Renick Educational Center, for 30 workdays, effective at the close of the workday, September 7, 2005, for just cause, including, but not limited to: violation of School Board Rules 6Gx13- 4A-1.21, Responsibilities and Duties, 6Gx13- 4A-1.213, Code of Ethics, and 6Gx13- 5D-1.07, Corporal Punishment-Prohibited. This action is taken in accordance with Sections 1001.32(2), 1012.22(1)(f), and 447.209, Florida Statutes.

You have waived, in writing, your right to an administrative hearing.

**RECOMMENDED**: That effective September 7, 2005, at the close of the workday, the School Board suspend Mr. Hansel B. Grant, Paraprofessional, at

Robert Renick Educational Center, for 30 workdays without pay.
