**SUBJECT:       REQUEST FOR AUTHORIZATION TO ENTER INTO A PERSONNEL  
ASSIGNMENT AGREEMENT WITH THE EARLY LEARNING  
COALITION OF MIAMI-DADE/MONROE**

**COMMITTEE:   SCHOOL SUPPORT ACCOUNTABILITY**

Miami-Dade County Public Schools (M-DCPS) is partnering with the Early Learning Coalition of Miami-Dade/Monroe to enhance the quality of early childhood services in Miami-Dade County. To that end, the Coalition has requested M-DCPS to provide seven (7) curriculum support specialists to work as mentor/coaches. They will be responsible for training, modeling, and monitoring implementation of the curricula for teachers at selected child care sites.

Authorization of the Board is requested to enter into a Personnel Assignment Agreement with the Early Learning Coalition of Miami-Dade/Monroe to permit seven (7) curriculum support specialists to serve as mentor/coaches.

The Early Learning Coalition of Miami-Dade/Monroe will provide full reimbursement for their salary and fringe benefits to M-DCPS in an amount equal to the collective salaries and benefits of the assigned personnel, per annum. The Coalition will also reimburse M-DCPS 18% of an administrator's salary for administrative support to the curriculum support specialists. Salary and fringe benefits amounts are contingent upon prevailing collective bargaining agreements with the United Teachers of Dade and/or any additional fringe benefits that may be negotiated.

**RECOMMENDED:** That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to enter into a Personnel Assignment Agreement with the Early Learning Coalition of Miami-Dade/Monroe for seven (7) curriculum support specialists to serve as mentor/coaches.

Full reimbursement of salary and fringe benefits for the seven (7) curriculum support specialists and the 18% of an administrator's salary for administrative support will be provided by Early Learning Coalition of Miami-Dade/Monroe to Miami-Dade County Public Schools.
