**SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR APPROVAL OF MEMORANDA OF UNDERSTANDING
 BETWEEN MIAMI-DADE COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOLS AND THE
 EXCLUSIVE BARGAINING AGENTS FOR EMPLOYEES RELATING TO
 THE MAKE-UP OF LOST WORK DAYS DUE TO THE IMPACT OF
 HURRICANES KATRINA, RITA AND WILMA**

COMMITTEE: SCHOOL SUPPORT ACCOUNTABILITY

Pursuant to provisions of the current contracts between Miami-Dade County Public Schools and United Teachers of Dade (UTD), American Federation of State, County, and Municipal Employees (AFSCME), Dade County School Maintenance Employee Committee (DCSMEC), Dade County School Administrators' Association (DCSAA) and Florida State Lodge, Fraternal Order of Police (FOP), the parties met to discuss the impact of Hurricanes Katrina, Rita and Wilma on the workdays of members of the Unions and the need to make up lost workdays. As a result, the parties entered into discussions to develop a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) to reflect the make up days needed.

Upon agreement by the Unions, the proposed MOUs will be presented to the Board for approval.
