COMMITTEE: **SCHOOL SUPPORT ACCOUNTABILITY**

The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, announced on December 15, 2004, April 13, 2005, and August 15, 2005, respectively, its intention to amend Board Rules 6Gx13- 6A-1.02, Elementary and Secondary School Calendar, effective July 28, 2005, 6Gx13- 6C-1.02, Adult/Vocational Education School Calendar, effective July 28, 2005, 6Gx13- 6A-1.024, School Improvement Zone School Calendar, effective July 22, 2005, and 6Gx13- 6A-1.023, Juvenile Justice Education Extended Year School Calendar, effective August 15, 2005.

In response to the emergency created by Hurricanes Katrina, Rita and Wilma, proposed revisions to the calendars are recommended. These revisions are designed to:

Elementary and Secondary

- Designate October 24, 25, 26, 27, and 28, 2005 as Teacher Planning Days.
- Eliminate December 16, 2005, February 17, 2006, March 17, 2006, May 25, 2006, and May 26, 2006, as Teacher Planning Days and designate as regular school days.
- Eliminate February 20, 2006, as a paid legal holiday and designate as a regular school day.
- Modify the third grading period to end March 3, 2006, prior to the administration of FCAT.
- Eliminate March 16, 2006 as Secondary Early Release Day
- Modify Spring Recess from April 10, 2006, through April 13, 2006.
- Designate April 14, 2006, as a paid legal holiday in observance of Pan American Day.
- Designate May 23, 2006 as Secondary Early Release

Adult/Vocation Education

- Designate October 24, 25, 26, 27, and 28, 2005 as Teacher Planning Days.
- Eliminate December 16, 2005, March 27, 2006, April 7, 2006, June 30, 2006, and July 19, 2006, as Teacher Planning Days and designate as regular school days.
- Eliminate February 20, 2006, as a paid legal holiday and designate as a regular school day.
- Modify Spring Recess from April 10, 2006, through April 13, 2006.
- Designate April 14, 2006, as a paid legal holiday in observance of Pan American Day.

School Improvement Zone

- Designate October 24, 25, 26, 27, and 28, 2005, as Teacher Planning Days.
- Eliminate December 16, 2005, February 17, 2006, March 17, 2006, May 30, 2006, and May 31, 2006, as Teacher Planning Days and designate as regular school days.
- Eliminate February 20, 2006, as a paid legal holiday and designate as a regular school day.
- Modify the third grading period to end March 3, 2006, prior to the administration of FCAT.
- Modify Spring Recess from April 10, 2006, through April 13, 2006.
- Designate April 14, 2006, as a paid legal holiday in observance of Pan American Day.

Juvenile Justice Education

- Designate October 24, 25, 26, 27, and 28, 2005, as Teacher Planning Days.
- Eliminate December 16, 2005, February 17, 2006, March 17, 2006, and August 4, 2006, as Teacher Planning Days and designate as regular school days.
- Designate January 7, 2006, and February 25, 2006, as Saturday School Days.
- Eliminate February 20, 2006, as a paid legal holiday and designate as a regular school day.
- Modify the third grading period to end March 3, 2006, prior to the administration of FCAT.
- Modify Spring Recess from April 10, 2006, through April 13, 2006.
- Designate April 14, 2006, as a paid legal holiday in observance of Pan American Day.

Attached are the Notice of Intended Action and Emergency Rules 6Gx13- ER 2005-2006, No. 1, Elementary and Secondary School Calendar, 6Gx13- ER 2005-2006, No. 2, Adult/Vocational Education School Calendar, 6Gx13- ER 2005-2006, No. 3, School Improvement Zone School Calendar, and 6Gx13- ER 2005-2006, No. 4, Juvenile Justice Education Extended Year School Calendar. Additionally, Memoranda of Understanding will be negotiated with each labor union to reflect the above revisions.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, adopt Emergency Rules 6Gx13- ER 2005-2006, No. 1, Elementary and Secondary School Calendar, 6Gx13- ER 2005-2006, No. 2, Adult/Vocational Education School Calendar, 6Gx13- ER 2005-2006, No. 3, School Improvement Zone School Calendar, and 6Gx13- ER 2005-2006, No. 4, Juvenile Justice Education Extended Year School Calendar, to be effective December 4, 2005.

NOTICE OF INTENDED ACTION TO ADOPT AN EMERGENCY RULE

THE SCHOOL BOARD OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA

RULE NUMBER 6Gx13- ER 2005-2006, No. 1, Elementary and Secondary School Calendar, 6Gx13- ER 2005-2006, No. 2, Adult/Vocational Education School Calendar, 6Gx13- ER 2005-2006, No. 3, School Improvement Zone School Calendar, and 6Gx13- ER 2005-2006, No. 4, Juvenile Justice Education Extended Year School Calendar.

SPECIFIC REASONS FOR FINDING AN IMMEDIATE DANGER TO PUBLIC HEALTH AND WELFARE: Public welfare requires that school calendars be established in order to allow the development of individual and district plans and so that employees may be compensated in a manner which will permit them to meet budgeted and legally required financial commitments.

REASONS WHY PROCEDURE USED IS FAIR UNDER THE CIRCUMSTANCES: It is essential to school operations that calendars be modified to meet state mandated attendance requirements.

SUMMARY OF THE EMERGENCY RULES: Establishes revised calendars for Elementary and Secondary Schools, Adult/Vocational Education Centers, School Improvement Zone Schools, and Juvenile Justice Education Centers in response to natural disaster created by Hurricane Wilma.
