REQUEST AUTHORIZATION TO ACCEPT TWO GRANT AWARDS FROM THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION (FLDOE) FOR FUNDING UNDER THE FLORIDA LEARN AND SERVE AMERICA SCHOOL-BASED PROGRAM AT BOOKER T. WASHINGTON AND WILLIAM H. TURNER TECHNICAL ARTS SENIOR HIGH SCHOOLS

COMMITTEE: INSTRUCTIONAL EXCELLENCE AND COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

The Corporation for National and Community Service, Learn and Serve America School-Based Program awards grants to the Florida Department of Education (FLDOE) to offer competitive grant opportunities to all eligible agencies. All schools were notified of this grant opportunity. The goal of the grant is to improve student performance, provide for civic engagement and career exploration, and address key needs in reading and civics/history. The grant involves students in service-learning activities such as drug/violence prevention, intergenerational interaction, and the environment. The grant supports service-learning projects that link academic courses to community service.

Authorization is requested to accept two grant awards from the FLDOE in the total amount of \$11,205, to fund the Florida Learn and Serve America School-Based Programs for the grant period of September 1, 2005, through August 31, 2006.

Six schools applied for this grant. Official notification of the awards for Miami Springs Middle, and John A. Ferguson, Miami Douglas MacArthur South, and North Miami Beach senior high schools were received in August 2005 and subsequently approved at the September 2005 School Board Meeting. The following two schools applied and received the grant award subsequent to the initial four schools to implement service-learning activities under this initiative:

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The match requirement for William H. Turner Technical Arts High School, at a value of \$2,912, is met by the in-kind contribution of Heiken Children's Vision Fund. This organization will donate free comprehensive eye health/vision examination and eyeglasses to students in the program that qualify for free and reduced lunch. No matching funds are required for Booker T. Washington Senior High School because the school received a planning grant, not a full award.

Grant funds in the amount of \$11,205, will be used for part-time hourly personnel, temporary instructor, professional and technical services, facility rental fees, travel, printing and duplicating, and supplies. Indirect cost is not allowed.

These grants will be managed by the individual schools. Official notifications of these grant awards were received on September 7, 2005, which is after the start of the grant period. Reimbursement of grant-related expenditures is authorized effective September 1, 2005.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to:

- 1. accept two grant awards from the Florida Department of Education (FLDOE) for funding under the Florida Learn and Serve America School-Based Program in the total amount of \$11,205, for the grant period of September 1, 2005, through August 31, 2006, at the following schools:
 - a. Booker T. Washington Senior High School, in the amount of \$1,500;
 - b. William H. Turner Technical Arts High School, in the amount of \$9,705;
- 2. extend these programs as authorized through official notification from the granting agency in order to complete the goals of the programs; and
- 3. direct Financial Operations to establish appropriations in the amounts approved or as amended by the granting agency; such appropriations to be reported periodically to the Board.
