SUBJECT: REQUEST AUTHORIZATION TO ACCEPT A GRANT AWARD FROM THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION (FLDOE) FOR FUNDING THE LEARNING FOR LIFE CHARACTER EDUCATION PROGRAM AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACTUAL AGREEMENT WITH LEARNING FOR LIFE, INC.

COMMITTEE: INSTRUCTIONAL EXCELLENCE AND COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

Under the 2005 General Appropriations Act, Specific Appropriation 86, authorizes the Florida Department of Education (FLDOE) to award grants to selected school districts implementing Learning for Life Character Education Programs provided by Learning for Life, Inc. The purpose of the Learning for Life Character Education Program is to improve student life skills/student achievement, with a focus on reading, writing, critical thinking, and career preparation; to build student character, which includes the development of self-worth, self-confidence, motivation, and ethical decision-making skills; and to improve classroom behavior.

Authorization is requested to accept a grant award in the amount of \$400,000, from the FLDOE and to enter into a contractual agreement with Learning for Life, Inc., in the amount of \$400,000, to implement the Character Education Program, for the grant period of July 1, 2005, through June 30, 2006.

No matching funds are required as a condition to receive the grant award. Grant funds in the amount of \$400,000, will be used for contracted services. Indirect cost is not allowed.

Official notification of this grant award was received on August 9, 2005, which is after the start of the grant period. Reimbursement of grant-related expenditures is authorized effective July 1, 2005. This program will be managed by the Division of Social Sciences.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to:

1. accept a grant award from the Florida Department of Education (FLDOE) for funding the Learning for Life Character Education Program in the amount of \$400,000, for the grant period of July 1, 2005, through June 30, 2006;
2. enter into a contractual agreement with Learning for Life, Inc., in the amount of \$400,000, for the contract period of July 1, 2005, through June 30, 2006;
3. extend this program and contractual agreement as authorized through official notification from the granting agency in order to complete the goals of the program; and
4. direct Financial Operations to establish appropriations in the amounts approved or as amended by the granting agency; such appropriations to be reported periodically to the Board.
