**SUBJECT: REQUEST AUTHORIZATION TO ACCEPT A GRANT AWARD
 FROM THE DAIRY COUNCIL OF FLORIDA FOR FUNDING THE
 BREAKFAST EXPANSION PROGRAM**

COMMITTEE: INSTRUCTIONAL EXCELLENCE AND COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

Authorization is requested to accept a grant award from the Dairy Council of Florida, in the amount of \$19,500, to fund the Breakfast Expansion Program in selected schools for the grant period of December 15, 2005, through June 15, 2006. The Dairy Council of Florida has made funds available to school districts to enhance and expand breakfast programs through promotion, education, and equipment purchases. The purpose of this program is to expand breakfast services to students by offering alternative serving methods such as breakfast in the classroom and/or breakfast-to-go. Research provides a strong correlation between breakfast and readiness to learn, improved behavior and cognitive skills. School Improvement Zone schools may elect to participate in the Breakfast Expansion Program. The grant supports the districtwide initiative of Student Wellness Education. The Department of Food and Nutrition will manage the grant.

No matching funds are required as a condition to receive the grant funding. Funds in the amount of \$19,500 will be used for food and supplies. Indirect cost is not allowed.

Official notification of this grant award was received on October 10, 2005. Reimbursement of grant-related expenditures is authorized effective December 15, 2005.

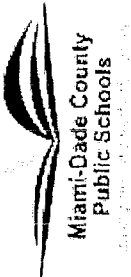
