At its meeting of November 16, 2005, in response to the emergency created by Hurricanes Katrina, Rita, and Wilma, The School Board of Miami-Dade County, "Florida, adopted Emergency Rules 6Gx13- <u>ER 2005-2006, No. 1</u>, Elementary and Secondary School Calendar, 2005-2006; 6Gx13- <u>ER 2005-2006, No. 2</u>, Adult/Vocational Education School Calendar, 2005-2006; 6Gx13- <u>ER 2005-2006, No. 3</u>, School Improvement Zone School Calendar, 2005-2006; and 6Gx13- <u>ER 2005-2006, No. 4</u>, Juvenile Justice Education Extended Year School Calendar, 2005-2006, which revised the school calendars for the 2005-2006 school year, effective December 4, 2005. The emergency rules expire March 3, 2006.

This item is submitted for consideration by the School Board to amend the rules pertaining to the school calendars for the 2005-2006 school year to incorporate the dates outlined in the emergency rules.
