**SUBJECT: AGREEMENT BETWEEN MIAMI-DADE COUNTY AND THE SCHOOL BOARD OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF WATER FACILITIES TO SERVICE THE ROCKWAY MIDDLE SCHOOL SITE (MODULAR CLASSROOM ADDITION) PROJECT NO. A01134**

**COMMITTEE: FACILITIES CONSTRUCTION AND REFORM**

In order to provide adequate fire protection services to the Rockway Middle (Modular Classroom Addition) School site, the Board must install and connect a water main, fire hydrants and other appurtenances to the existing Miami-Dade County (County) infrastructure (see location map).

The 11-acre school site is located at 9393 SW 29 Terrace. A proposed 8-inch water main will interconnect to an existing County-owned 8-inch water main west of SW 92 Place and extend westerly on SW 29 Terrace to the southwest corner of Board-owned property. In addition, an onsite water main extension and offsite tap will be required in order to provide adequate fire protection to the proposed addition. Three Fire Hydrants will be required. The approximate cost for the installation of these water facilities is \$244,000.

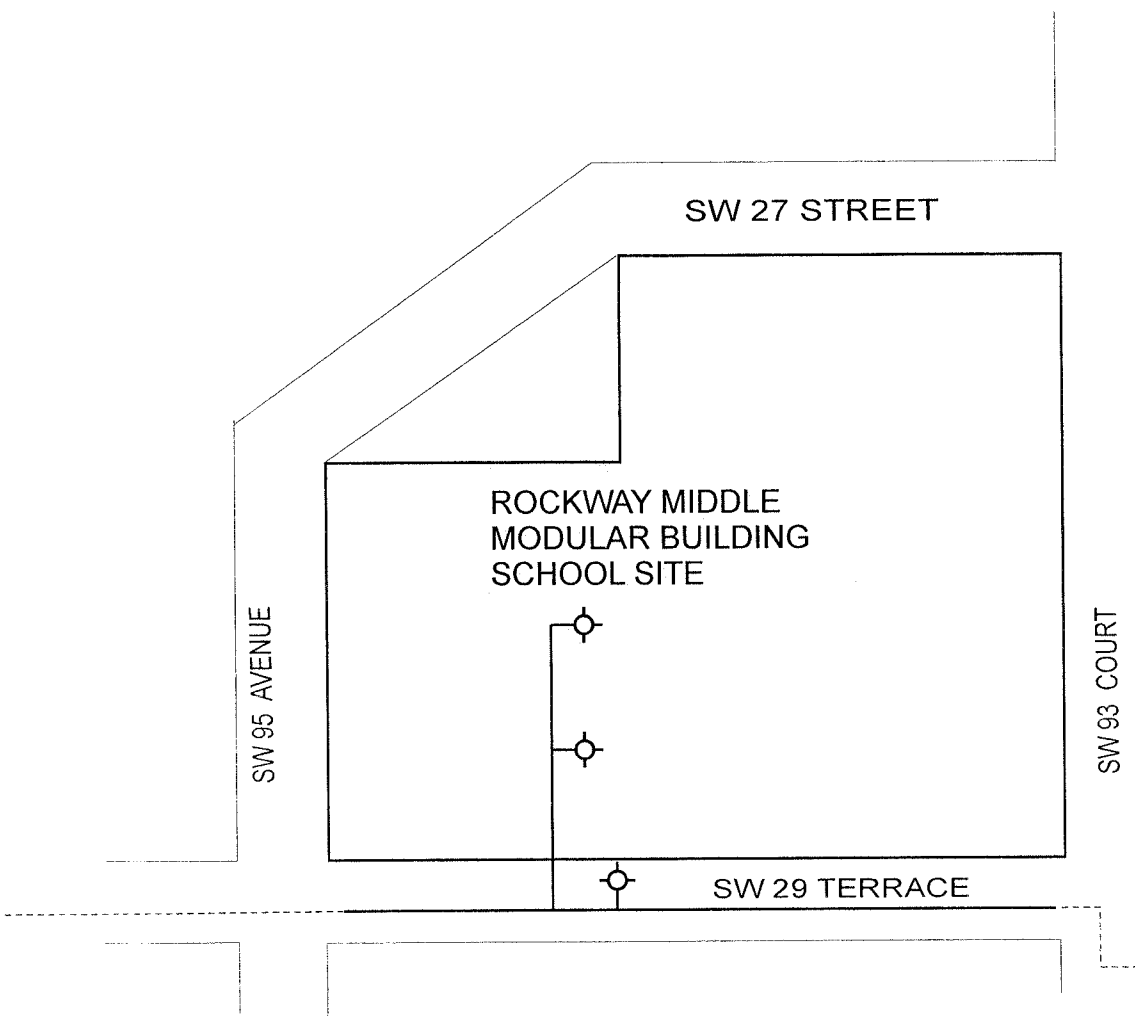
The agreement for the water facilities installation has been reviewed and recommended by the Office of School Facilities and the School Board Attorney's Office. Public utility facilities constructed on Board-owned property will be conveyed, with appropriate easements, to Miami-Dade County for future maintenance and operation.

**RECOMMENDED:** That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent or his designee to execute an agreement with Miami-Dade County and the execution of relevant conveyance documents for the provision of water services for planned improvements at the Rockway Middle School site, (Modular Classroom Addition) Project No. A01134, at an approximate cost not to exceed \$244,000, which is included in the construction contract.
