**SUBJECT: REQUEST AUTHORIZATION TO ACCEPT A GRANT AWARD FROM
HEALTH FOUNDATION OF SOUTH FLORIDA FOR FUNDING THE
HEALTHY EATING/HEALTHY CHOICES PROGRAM AT THE DAVID
LAWRENCE JR. K-8 CENTER**

COMMITTEE: INSTRUCTIONAL EXCELLENCE AND COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

Authorization is requested to accept a grant award from the Health Foundation of South Florida in the total amount of \$27,000, to fund the David Lawrence Jr. K-8 Center Healthy Eating/Healthy Choices Program for the grant period of December 5, 2005, through December 31, 2006. The Health Foundation of South Florida, a not-for-profit grantmaking foundation, is dedicated to expanding access to affordable, quality health care and providing funding that directly benefits the health and well-being of under-served individuals in Broward, Miami-Dade, and Monroe counties. Since its inception in 1993, the Foundation has awarded more than \$50 million in grants and direct program support. David Lawrence Jr. K-8 Center submitted a grant application at the invitation of the Foundation to support the Healthy Eating/Healthy Choices Program at the school. This program will educate students and parents on the importance of healthy eating and proper nutrition and will educate families regarding the impact of proper nutrition on student achievement. This program supports the Superintendent's initiative to enhance student wellness education and will be managed by the school.

No matching funds are required as a condition to receive the grant award. The David Lawrence Jr. K-8 Center is scheduled to open in the Fall of 2006. Prior to opening the school, the funds will be used to strategically plan for the Healthy Eating/Healthy Choices Program. Grant funds in the amount of \$27,000 will be used for part-time hourly wages, supplies, consulting fees, and registration fees. Indirect cost is not allowed.

Official notification of this grant award was received on January 24, 2006, which is after the start of the grant period. Reimbursement of grant-related expenditures is authorized effective December 5, 2005.

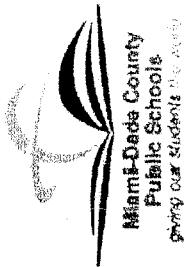
RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to:

2. extend this program and contractual agreements as authorized through official notification from the granting agency in order to complete the goals of the program; and
3. direct Financial Operations to establish appropriations in the amounts approved or as amended by the granting agency; such appropriations to be reported periodically to the Board.
