**SUBJECT: SUSPENSION OF EMPLOYEE
ROBERT S. BOUNDY - TEACHER
NAUTILUS MIDDLE SCHOOL**

On March 1, 2006, the following letter was sent to Mr. Robert S. Boundy:

This is to notify you that the Superintendent of Schools will be recommending to The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, at its scheduled meeting of March 15, 2006, that the School Board suspend you without pay from your current position as Teacher at Nautilus Middle School, for 30 workdays effective at the close of the workday, March 15, 2006, for just cause, including, but not limited to: deficient performance of job responsibilities; conduct unbecoming a School Board employee; and violation of State Board Rule 6B-1.001, Code of Ethics of the Education Profession in Florida; and School Board Rules 6Gx13-4A-1.21, Responsibilities and Duties; and 6Gx13- 5D-1.07, Corporal Punishment--Prohibited. This action is taken in accordance with Sections 1001.32(2), 1001.42(5), 1012.22(1)(f), 1012.33, and 447.209, Florida Statutes; and the **Contract between the Miami-Dade County Public Schools and the United Teachers of Dade.**

If you wish to contest your suspension, you must request a hearing in writing within 15 calendar days of the receipt of notice of the Board action, in which case, formal charges will be filed and a hearing will be held before an administrative law judge.

If the School Board accepts (or approves) the Superintendent's recommendation, you will be notified of the School Board's action.

RECOMMENDED: That effective March 15, 2006, the School Board suspend Mr. Robert S. Boundy, Teacher at Nautilus Middle School, for 30 workdays without pay, pending the outcome of a hearing, if requested.
