SUBJECT: AGREEMENT BETWEEN MIAMI-DADE COUNTY AND THE SCHOOL BOARD OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF WATER FACILITIES TO SERVICE THE HOWARD DRIVE ELEMENTARY (MODULAR CLASSROOM ADDITION) SCHOOL SITE PROJECT NO. 00178400

COMMITTEE: FACILITIES AND CONSTRUCTION REFORM

In order to provide adequate fire protection services to the Howard Drive Elementary(Modular Classroom Addition)School site, the Board must install and connect a water main, fire hydrants and other appurtenances to the existing Miami-Dade County (County) infrastructure (see location map).

The 9-acre school site is located at 7750 SW 136 Street. A proposed 8-inch water main will interconnect to an existing County-owned 8-inch water main at SW 77Avenue, extend west to a point in Board-owned property, extend north and interconnect to an existing County-owned 20-inch water main on SW 136 Street, in order to provide adequate fire protection to the proposed addition. The approximate cost for the installation of these wastewater facilities is \$112,000.

The agreement for the water facilities installation has been reviewed and recommended by the Office of School Facilities. The School Board Attorney's Office will review and approve prior to execution. Utility facilities constructed on Board-owned property will be conveyed, with appropriate easements, to Miami-Dade County for future maintenance and operation.

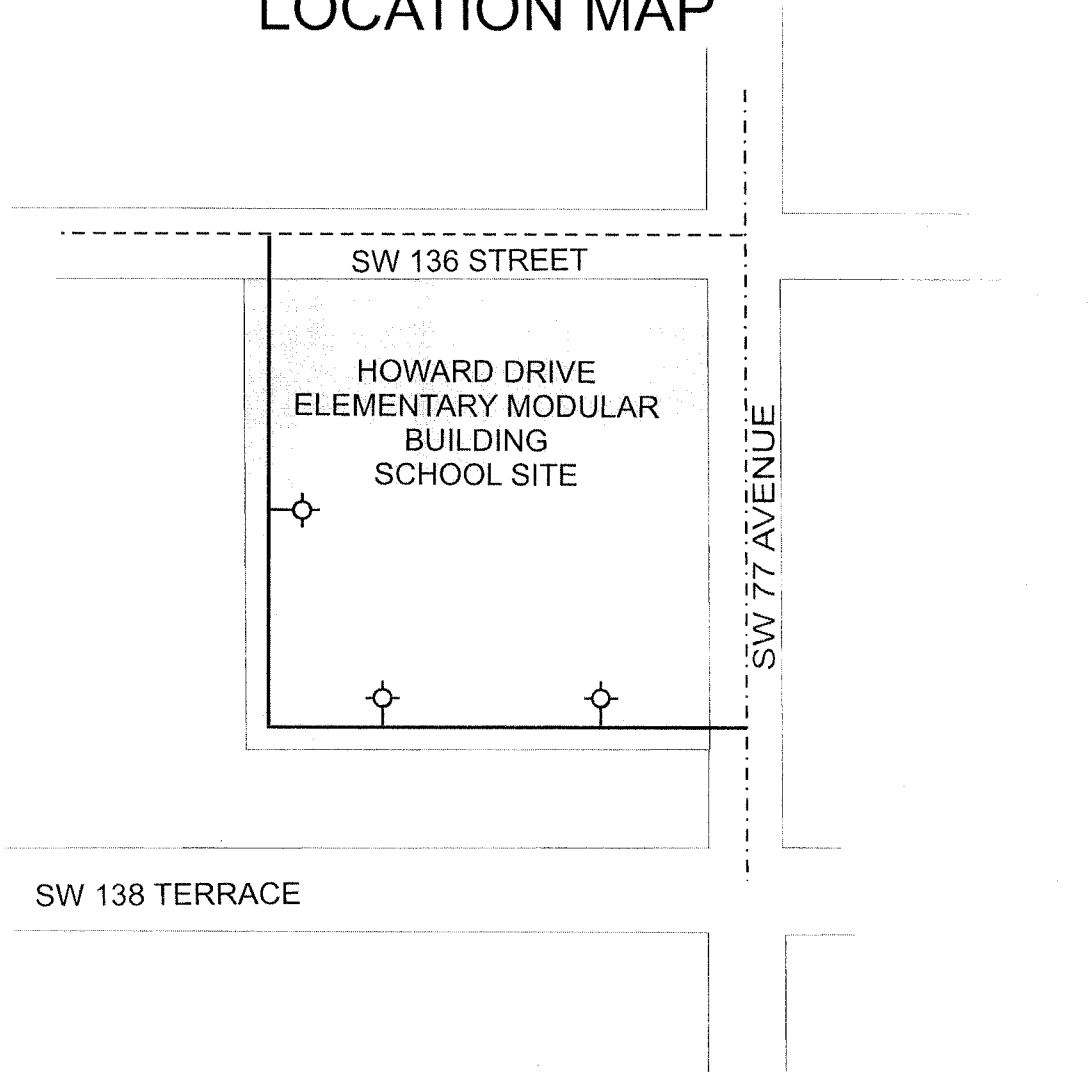



