**SUBJECT: AUTHORIZE THE SUPERINTENDENT TO EXECUTE A LEASE
EXTENSION WITH THE HOMESTEAD HOUSING AUTHORITY FOR
THE CONTINUED PLACEMENT OF PORTABLE CLASSROOMS AT
THE REDLAND LABOR CAMP, LOCATED AT 29355 SOUTH DIXIE
HIGHWAY, AND SOUTH DADE LABOR CAMP, LOCATED AT
13600 SW 312 STREET, FOR THE MIGRANT CHILD PROGRAM,
FOR THE PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 2006**

COMMITTEE: FACILITIES AND CONSTRUCTION REFORM

The District has operated the Migrant Child Program at the Redland and South Dade Labor Camps since March 1995, and the current lease agreements will expire March 23, 2006. Staff is finalizing terms and conditions for new lease agreements with the Homestead Housing Authority (HHA), for the continued placement of Board-owned portable classrooms at each location. In order to facilitate this process, HHA has agreed to extend the term of the lease at both locations through June 30, 2006.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent or his designee to execute a lease extension with the Homestead Housing Authority for the continued placement of portable classrooms at the Redland Labor Camp, located at 29355 South Dixie Highway, and South Dade Labor Camp, located at 13600 SW 312 street, for the Migrant Child Program, for the period ending June 30, 2006.
