Background

Since 1991, the District has utilized a contracting method known as Job Order Contracting (JOC), which is used to acquire general construction services to execute minor construction and capitalized maintenance projects. Work orders are based on competitively bid unit pricing.

Renewal of Contractual Agreement

At its meeting of February 16 2005, The School Board approved an award to Weiss and Woolrich Contracting Co., Inc. for Job Order Contracting Services, with a maximum amount of \$6,000,000, with two renewal options. The first option was exercised by the Board at its meeting of July 13, 2005. After evaluating the services rendered by Weiss and Woolrich Contracting Co., Facilities Operations, Maintenance has determined that this contractor has performed satisfactorily and is requesting authorization to renew the contractual agreement for an additional period of one year.

The current contract expires on July 12, 2006, and the one-year renewal period will commence on the date that the current contract meets the maximum value, or on June 13, 2006, whichever occurs first. Article 14 of the contract also prescribes a cost adjustment based on the Construction Cost Index as published by Engineering News Record. This adjustment results in an overall cost increase of 4.47% to the unit prices.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida authorize the Superintendent to renew the contractual agreement with Weiss and Woolrich Contracting Co., Inc., Contract No. JOC 05-C12A, in conformance with Article 14 of the contract, for a period of one year, commencing on the date the current contract meets the maximum value, or on July 13, 2006 whichever occurs first.
