What started as a mother's desire to help her busy student athlete son meet Miami-Dade County Public Schools (M-DCPS) community service graduation requirement turned into a win-win situation for older and younger students alike.

Marion Chase and her son Nick, an avid reader and student athlete at South Miami Senior High School, developed Real Athletes Care About Education (R.A.C.E.) to give community service its proper perspective in the often-hectic world of high school student athletes who strive to excel in the classroom and on the playing field.

The Chase's thought that if each student athlete could find new books to give to younger students then a good deed could promote reading as well. After several meetings with school administrators and coaches, the R.A.C.E. for Literacy Program got an enthusiastic go ahead, and today more than 500 new books have been donated.

The student athletes gave these new books to students at South Miami and Coral Terrace elementary schools, and scheduled time to read these books to the children at the schools. Much goodwill and many smiles were garnered from these simple acts of giving and sharing. The R.A.C.E. for Literacy Program is an innovative, grassroots success story that is worthy of replication in other M-DCPS senior high schools.
