**SUBJECT: DISMISSAL OF EMPLOYEE WITH PROFESSIONAL SERVICE

The following instructional employee has been notified that the Superintendent of Schools will be recommending to The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, at its scheduled meeting of June 14, 2006, that the School Board suspend him and initiate dismissal proceedings against him from his current position, effective at the close of the workday, June 14, 2006, for just cause, including, but not limited to: lack of good moral character; misconduct in office; immorality; violation of School Board Rules 6Gx13- 4A-1.21, Responsibilities and Duties and 6Gx13- 4A-1.213, Code of Ethics; and violation of State Board Rules 6B-1.001(3) and 6B-1.006(5). This action is taken in accordance with Sections 1001.32(2), 1012.22(1)(f), 1012.32(1), 1012.33, and 447.209 Florida Statutes.
