**SUBJECT: SUSPENSION OF EMPLOYEE
SHARLINE TURNER – ELEMENTARY SCHOOL ASSISTANT
HOLMES ELEMENTARY SCHOOL**

On July 19, 2006, the following letter was sent to Ms. Sharline Turner:

This is to notify you that the Superintendent of Schools will be recommending to The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, at its scheduled meeting of August 2, 2006, that the School Board suspend you without pay from your current position as Elementary School Assistant at Holmes Elementary School, for 30 workdays effective at the close of the workday, August 2, 2006, for just cause, including, but not limited to: violation of School Board Rules 6Gx13- 4-1.08, Violence in the Workplace, 6Gx13- 4A-1.21, Responsibilities and Duties, and 6Gx13- 5D-1.07, Corporal Punishment-Prohibited. This action is taken in accordance with Sections 1001.32(2), 1012.22(1)(f), and 447.209, Florida Statutes.

If you wish to contest your suspension, you must request a hearing in writing within 15 calendar days of the receipt of notice of the Board action, in which case, formal charges will be filed and a hearing will be held before an administrative law judge.

If the School Board accepts (or approves) the Superintendent's recommendation, you will be notified of the School Board's action.

RECOMMENDED: That effective August 2, 2006, the School Board suspend Ms. Sharline Turner, Elementary School Assistant at Holmes Elementary School, for 30 workdays without pay, pending the outcome of a hearing, if requested.
