**SUBJECT: SUSPENSION OF EMPLOYEE
MARCOS ACEVEDO - TEACHER
MIAMI SPRINGS SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL**

On August 31, 2006, the following letter was sent to Mr. Marcos Acevedo:

This is to notify you that the Superintendent of Schools will be recommending to The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, at its scheduled meeting of September 13, 2006, that the School Board suspend you without pay from your current position as Teacher at Miami Springs Senior High School, for 30 workdays effective at the close of the workday, September 13, 2006, for just cause, including, but not limited to: violation of School Board Rules 6Gx13-4A-1.21, Responsibilities and Duties, and 6Gx13-4A-1.213, Code of Ethics; and violation of State Board of Education Rules 6B-1.001, Code of Ethics of the Education Profession in Florida; and 6B-1.006, Principles of Professional Conduct for the Education Profession in Florida. This action is taken in accordance with Sections 1001.32(2), 1012.22(1)(f), and 447.209, Florida Statutes; and Article XXI, Section 1B of the **Contract between the Miami-Dade County Public Schools and the United Teachers of Dade.**

If you wish to contest your suspension, you must request a hearing in writing within 15 calendar days of the receipt of notice of the Board action, in which case, formal charges will be filed and a hearing will be held before an administrative law judge.

If the School Board accepts (or approves) the Superintendent's recommendation, you will be notified of the School Board's action.

RECOMMENDED: That effective September 13, 2006, the School Board suspend Mr. Marcos Acevedo, Teacher at Miami Springs Senior High School, for 30 workdays without pay, pending the outcome of a hearing, if requested.
