The Department of Food and Nutrition and Miami-Dade County Public Schools Food Service Association request that the Board adopt Resolution No. 06-53 proclaiming the week of October 9-13, 2006, as National School Lunch Week. National School Lunch Week is a special week made possible by the School Nutrition Association, when attention is focused on the benefits of school meals.

The primary goal of the Child Nutrition Program is to improve the health and nutritional status of students. This year's theme "**Vote for School Lunch**" will deliver important messages about the National School Lunch Program and provide a fun way for students to get involved in the voting process. Activities to promote the theme, "**Vote for School Lunch**" during National School Lunch Week include a national on-line "poll" for students to select their favorite lunch choice at www.VoteForSchoolLunch.org, menu promotions highlighting nutritious choices, press releases promoting school lunch and letters to parents highlighting the benefits of school lunch.

Studies have shown that students who consume nutritious meals have the greatest success in school. Food service managers have been provided materials to involve principals, teachers, students, parents, and the community in planned nutrition-related activities during this special week. These materials include nutrition-related activity sheets for students, suggestions to run school-wide "campaigns" for student's favorite lunch items and ideas for community involvement, such as inviting government leaders, parents and other guests to visit school lunch programs during this celebratory week.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, adopt Resolution No. 06-53 proclaiming the week of October 9-13, 2006, as National School Lunch Week.
