**SUBJECT: REQUEST SCHOOL BOARD APPROVAL OF THE CHARTER
SCHOOL APPLICATION FOR MIAMI COMMUNITY CHARTER
MIDDLE SCHOOL, INC., ON BEHALF OF MIAMI COMMUNITY
CHARTER MIDDLE SCHOOL AND AUTHORIZATION TO
NEGOTIATE A CONTRACTUAL AGREEMENT FOR A TERM OF
FIVE YEARS**

COMMITTEE: INSTRUCTIONAL EXCELLENCE AND COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

As established in School Board Rule 6Gx13- 6A-1.47, Charter Schools (K-12), Miami-Dade County Public Schools (M-DCPS) has received charter school applications from individuals and/or organizations in the community.

On November 7, 2006, M-DCPS Charter School District Review Committee met to review the application for Miami Community Charter Middle School and by a unanimous vote made a recommendation for approval of the application to the Superintendent of Schools.

The charter school proposes to serve a maximum of 484 students in grades six through eight, with a maximum of 300 students in its first year of operation, commencing with the 2007-2008 school year and continuing throughout the term of the contract which ends on June 30, 2012, and concludes in the 2011-2012 school year.

The following is the Founding Board for the charter school: Mr. Ruben Spitaleri, Business Manager, Ms. Michelle Diaz, Property Manager, and Ms. Rosita Atitus, Nurse.

The charter school contractual agreement will be submitted for School Board consideration at a subsequent meeting at which time there will be a public hearing to provide for community input.
