SUBJECT: REQUEST SCHOOL BOARD APPROVAL OF THE CHARTER SCHOOL APPLICATION FOR ROMANS SCHOOLS INC., ON BEHALF OF ROMANS CHARTER SCHOOL AND AUTHORIZATION TO NEGOTIATE A CONTRACTUAL AGREEMENT FOR A TERM OF TEN YEARS

COMMITTEE: INSTRUCTIONAL EXCELLENCE AND COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

As established in School Board Rule 6Gx13- 6A-1.47, Charter Schools (K-12), Miami-Dade County Public Schools (M-DCPS) has received charter school applications from individuals and/or organizations in the community.

On October 31, 2006, M-DCPS Charter School District Review Committee met to review the application for Romans Charter School and by a majority vote made a recommendation for approval of the application to the Superintendent of Schools.

The charter school proposes to serve a maximum of 536 students in grades kindergarten through five with a maximum of 354 students in grades kindergarten through three in its first year of operation, commencing with the 2007-2008, and continuing throughout the term of the contract, which ends on June 30, 2017, and concludes in the 2016-2017 school year.

The following is the Founding Board for the charter school : Mr. Pedro J. Martinez-Fraga, Jr., Attorney, Mr. Jorge J. Arrastia, Insurance Executive, Ms. Maria Rodriguez, Educator, Mr. Pedro J. Martinez-Fraga, Sr., Communication Consultant, Ms. Maritza Aragon, Educator, Mr. Luis Casas, Business and Marketing Executive, and Mr. Mario Hernandez-Fumero, Broker.

The charter school contractual agreement will be submitted for School Board consideration at a subsequent meeting at which time there will be a public hearing to provide for community input.
