**SUBJECT: REQUEST SCHOOL BOARD DENIAL OF THE CHARTER SCHOOL
APPLICATION FOR SOMERSET ACADEMY, INC., ON BEHALF OF
SOMERSET ACADEMY MIDDLE SCHOOL (SOUTH CAMPUS)**

COMMITTEE: INSTRUCTIONAL EXCELLENCE AND COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

As established in School Board Rule 6Gx13- 6A-1.47, Charter Schools (K-12), Miami-Dade County Public Schools (M-DCPS) has received charter school applications from individuals and/or organizations in the community.

On November 27, 2006, M-DCPS Charter School District Review Committee met to review the application for Somerset Academy Middle School (South Campus) and by a unanimous vote made a recommendation for approval of the application to the Superintendent of Schools.

However, serious concerns have recently been raised as a consequence of an ongoing investigation by the School Board's Chief Auditor involving possible undisclosed related party transactions and other governance issues at an existing charter school involving the applicant's management company, Academica, Inc. The State Attorney's Office has also recently opened an investigation into the matter. In light of these pending investigations and concerns regarding the School's management company, it is recommended that this application for a new charter school, which involves Academica Inc., be denied at this time.
