REQUEST AUTHORIZATION TO ACCEPT A GRANT AWARD FROM THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION (FLDOE) FOR FUNDING UNDER THE PUBLIC CHARTER SCHOOL FEDERAL GRANT PROGRAM

## COMMITTEE: INSTRUCTIONAL EXCELLENCE AND COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

Authorization is requested to accept a grant award from the Florida Department of Education (FLDOE) in the amount of \$51,800, to fund the Public Charter School Federal Grant Program for Sunshine Academy Charter School, for the grant period of July 21, 2006, through December 31, 2006.

The FLDOE issued a Request for Applications under the Public Charter School Federal Grant Program for the purpose of awarding grants to charter schools partnering with local educational agencies in order to provide a high quality education for all students. Funds received from these grants will be used to improve the quality of education, support planning activities, and supplement the level of funds that would be made available from non-federal sources.

In accordance with the FLDOE grant guidelines, Miami-Dade County Public Schools (M-DCPS) must be the fiscal agent on behalf of each of the charter schools that receive such grants. The Board's approval of the recommended action would not constitute an endorsement of the grant or its intended use. It would merely satisfy the Board's requirement under Florida Statutes, Section 1002.33, Charter Schools, which requires that M-DCPS serve as the fiscal agent.

No matching funds are required as condition to receive the grant funding.

Official notification of the grant award was received on November 6, 2006, which is after the start of the grant period. Reimbursement of grant-related expenditures is authorized effective July 21, 2006.

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## RECOMMENDED:

That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to:

- 1. accept a grant award from the Florida Department of Education (FLDOE) for funding under the Public Charter School Federal Grant Program in the total amount of \$51,800, for the grant period of July 21, 2006, through December 31, 2006;
- disburse grant funds in the total amount of \$51,206, to Sunshine Academy Charter School, Inc., on behalf of Sunshine Academy Charter School, in the amount of \$51,206, for the grant period July 21, 2006, through December 31, 2006;
- retain funds from the grant in an amount not to exceed the annually negotiated indirect cost rate, as allowed and approved by the FLDOE;
- 4. extend this program as authorized through official notification from the granting agency in order to complete the goals of the program; and
- 5. direct Financial Operations to establish appropriations in the amounts approved or as amended by the granting agency; such appropriations to be reported periodically to the Board.
