Pursuant to Board Rule 6Gx13- 7E -1.02, Educational Facilities – Naming, The Educational Facilities Naming Committee met on March 13, 2007, to review all documents submitted for consideration and present the following recommendation proposed by Ms. Perla Tabares Hantman, Board Member, The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida. State School WWW will be located in Regional Center III at 4000 West 18th Avenue, Hialeah, Florida.

The committee comprised of Mr. Agustin J. Barrera, Chair, Miami-Dade County Public Schools; Ms. Perla Tabares Hantman, Board Member, Miami-Dade County Public Schools; Ms. Grecia Ameneiro, Board Member Designee, Miami-Dade County Public Schools; Mr. Freddie Woodson, Associate Superintendent, School Operations; Mr. George Nuñez, Regional Center III Superintendent; and Ms. Daiqueline Pino, Community Representative, Regional Center III, recommends that State School WWW be named Westland Hialeah Senior High School.
