Greer, Member, The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida. State School SS-1 will be located in Regional Center VI at 29100 SW 194 Avenue, Homestead, Florida.

The committee, comprised of Mr. Agustin J. Barrera, Chair, Miami-Dade County Public Schools; Ms. Evelyn L. Greer, Board Member, Ms. Cheri Ball, Board Designee, Miami-Dade County Public Schools; Mr. Freddie Woodson, Associate Superintendent, School Operations; Ms. Neyda G. Navarro, Regional Center VI Superintendent; Mr. James Anderson, Community Representative, Regional Center VI; recommends that State School SS-1 be named South Dade Middle School.
