**SUBJECT: THE SCHOOL BOARD OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA v. JAVIER PERAZA, DOAH Case No. 06-1756**

On May 10, 2006, the School Board took action to suspend and initiate dismissal proceedings against Javier Peraza, a teacher with Miami-Dade County Public Schools. The charges included violation of School Board Rules 6Gx13- 4A-1.21, *Responsibilities and Duties*, and 6Gx13- 4A-1.213, *Code of Ethics*. Mr. Peraza requested an administrative hearing on the termination of his employment and the hearing was held on September 11, 2006, via video teleconference before Administrative Law Judge Errol H. Powell.

By Recommended Order entered February 1, 2007, the Administrative Law Judge recommended that the School Board enter a final order reinstating Javier Peraza with back pay and benefits.

**RECOMMENDED:** That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida enter a Final Order accepting the Administrative Law Judge's Recommended Order in the case of The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida v. Javier Peraza, DOAH Case No. 06-1756, reinstating Javier Peraza as a teacher with back pay and benefits.
