SUBJECT: THE SCHOOL BOARD OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA v. CARLOS LEGOAS, DOAH CASE NO. 06-2919

On May 10, 2006, the School Board took action to suspend and initiate dismissal proceedings against Carlos Legoas, an ROTC teacher with Miami-Dade County Public Schools. The charges included violation of School Board Rule 6Gx13- 4-1.09, Employee-Student Relationships. A hearing was held on January 31, 2007, before Administrative Law Judge Patricia M. Hart.

By Recommended Order entered February 1, 2007, the Administrative Law Judge recommended that the School Board enter a final order dismissing all charges against Carlos Legoas, rescinding his suspension and awarding him back pay and benefits.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida enter a Final Order accepting the Administrative Law Judge's Recommended Order in the case of The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida v. Carlos Legoas, DOAH Case No. 06-2919, dismissing all charges against Carlos Legoas, rescinding his suspension and awarding him back pay and benefits.
