**SUBJECT: SELECTION PROCESS FOR THE INSPECTOR GENERAL**

On September 13, 2006, the School Board approved Board Agenda Item E-149 to engage the services of Korn/Ferry International, an executive search firm, to conduct a national search to identify and screen potential candidates for the position of Inspector General.

The Inspector General Selection Committee received the resumes of five individuals chosen by Korn/Ferry International on January 22, 2007. They were Mark Duda, Robert Emmons, Hilton Green, Robert Lawrence, and Richard West. On January 24, 2007, the Inspector General Selection Committee interviewed these five candidates and decided to recommend to the Audit Committee the following three individuals:

- Robert Emmons
- Hilton Green
- Richard West

On January 30, 2007, the recommended candidates were approved by the Audit Committee.
