Miami-Dade County Public Schools (M-DCPS) has concluded its successful 2006 United Way campaign, with total contributions reaching \$2,551,825. The employee campaign raised \$1,734,153, and the student campaign raised \$817,672. The District had the most successful school district campaign in the nation again this year, and continues to be the only institution with a campaign of more than \$2,000,000 in Miami-Dade County.

Under the theme of "Building Community One Student at a Time," all of the District's labor unions and bargaining units participated in the United Way campaign and were instrumental in its success. The participation of M-DCPS employees, students, labor unions and bargaining units in the United Way of Miami-Dade campaign is in keeping with the school system's long-standing support of United Way, which in turn funds more than 100 community programs that provide social services that help thousands of men, women, and children in Miami-Dade County.
