**SUBJECT: REQUEST AUTHORIZATION FOR THE SUPERINTENDENT TO
ACCEPT REVENUE FROM THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF
HIGHWAY SAFETY AND MOTOR VEHICLES FOR COMMERCIAL
DRIVER LICENSE (CDL) TRAINING, REVENUE WILL NOT EXCEED
\$50,000**

The Florida Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles has been awarded a Florida Motor Carrier Safety Administration (FMSA) grant to implement a new Commercial Driver License (CDL) testing model. This system improved and strengthened the procedures for the vehicle inspection, basic control skills and road test components of the CDL testing process. Grant project activities began in December 2006 with an American Association of Motor Vehicle Administrators (AAMVA) "Train-the-Trainer" workshop on the 2005 Model CDL Testing Systems. This workshop prepared instructors from the institutions within the public school system that now train all Florida CDL testers. The grant further includes funding for those institutions to retrain current CDL testers on the new system. This direct order (DO) provides payment to the institution for the testers' tuition.

Payment will be made at the rate of \$1,190.83 per student upon submission of an invoice with a listing of students completing the training. This training program will be offered at Miami Lakes Educational Center. The funds will be deposited into the Truck Driver Training account. The revenue is not expected to exceed \$50,000.

No additional funds will be required to implement this program.
