## NOTICE OF INTENDED ACTION

THE SCHOOL BOARD OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, announced on March 14, 2007, its intention to amend Board Rule 6Gx13- <u>5A-1.10</u>, Attendance Areas 2007-2008 and 2008-2009, at its meeting of May 16, 2007.

PURPOSE AND EFFECT: To establish attendance zones for elementary and secondary schools for the 2007-2008 and 2008-2009 school years, which, in effect, relieves overcrowding and better utilizes existing student stations.

SUMMARY: Board approval of this rule would modify previously approved attendance zones and subsequently establish all Board-approved attendance zones as a Board rule.

## Attendance

## ATTENDANCE AREAS 2007-2008 and 2008-2009

The Superintendent of Schools is responsible for proposing attendance areas for the district schools. The Superintendent of Schools will be assisted in this task by School Operations, the Office of School Facilities, and the Attendance Boundary Committee.

To comply with the mandate of Class Size Reduction, the Office of School Facilities and School Operations will provide the Attendance Boundary Committee and the community with attendance boundaries for schools opening in 2007-2008 and 2008-2009. Community and Attendance Boundary Committee meetings will be held to present the attendance boundaries established for 2007-2008 and 2008-2009.

The Attendance Boundary Committee will take the following factors into consideration when reviewing proposed attendance areas regarding school boundaries: compliance with Class Size Reduction Mandate, impact on exceptional student special education programs, use of available student stations within contiguous areas, degree and extent of transportation, programmatic impact due to lack of student housing, reduction of the number of schools students must attend, integrity of feeder systems, assignment of students from new residential developments to specific schools prior to completion of developments, construction of new schools, promotion and maintenance of diverse school enrollments, and prevention, reduction or elimination of racial isolation to the extent practicable.

Staff in School Operations, Office of School Facilities, Information Technology Services, Department of Transportation, Research Services, Civil Rights and Diversity Compliance, and Office of Intergovernmental Affairs, Grants Administration and Community Services will assist the Superintendent of Schools in providing data, analyze proposed attendance areas and prepare recommendations for submission to the Board.

The Board-approved school attendance zones for the current school year are contained in the following documents:

- 2. Attendance Zone Recommendations and Related Administrative Actions 2006-2007 2007-2008 and 2008-2009
