SUBJECT: POTENTIAL HEALTH RISK AT MIAMI-DADE COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOLS

Rodents pose a serious and potential health risk. The health department has found rodents and other pests at more than 40 of our schools. This is an unacceptable situation that must be remedied immediately. In addition, parents are upset that they are not notified when these unsanitary conditions arise and do not know what is being done to remedy the situation.

A procedure needs to be set up so that parents are notified of the existing problems and are advised of the course of action that Miami-Dade County Public Schools is undertaking to remedy the situation.

That The Superintendent of Miami-Dade County Public Schools provide the School Board of Miami-Dade County a detailed report of the County Health Department findings at Miami-Dade County Public Schools with a corrective action plan that includes informing parents, by the June 13, 2007, School Board meeting.
