SUBJECT: REQUEST AUTHORIZATION TO ACCEPT A GRANT AWARD FROM THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION (FLDOE) FOR FUNDING THE TO REACH ULTIMATE SUCCESS TOGETHER (TRUST) PROGRAM UNDER THE SAFE AND DRUG-FREE SCHOOLS PROGRAM

STRATEGIC PLAN: IMPROVE RETURN ON INVESTMENT OF GRANT DOLLARS

Authorization is requested to accept a grant award from the Florida Department of Education (FLDOE), in the approximate amount of \$2,330,728, to fund the To Reach Ultimate Success Together (TRUST) Program for the grant period of July 1, 2007, through June 30, 2008. The FLDOE has allocated funding to Miami-Dade County Public Schools under the Safe and Drug-Free Schools (SDFS) Program. The funding allocation for this entitlement grant is based upon Districtwide student enrollment and the percentage of students on free and reduced price lunch. This program is managed by the Division of Student Services.

The goal of the District's TRUST Program is to provide violence and drug prevention and intervention services for students, as well as training and technical assistance for elementary, middle, and senior high school teachers, administrators, counselors, TRUST specialists, and safe school Specialists. The 2006-2007 FLDOE allocation for the SDFS Program was \$2,355,000.

The TRUST specialists focus on counseling students to solve problems related to drugs and alcohol, stress, suicide, isolation, family violence, and other crises. The safe school specialists provide training and followup activities to all school staff in the areas of violence prevention, stress management and crisis management. The TRUST Program supports the District's School Wellness Policy.

No matching funds are required as a condition to receive this grant funding. Grant funds will be used to continue to fund 22 middle school TRUST specialists, 8 safe school specialists, 1 staff specialist, and 3 curriculum support specialists. These funds will also be used for contracted services, supplies, and travel.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to:

1. accept a grant award from the Florida Department of Education (FLDOE) for funding the To Reach Ultimate Success Together (TRUST) Program under the Safe and Drug-Free Schools Program in the approximate amount of \$2,330,728, for the grant period of July 1, 2007, through June 30, 2008;
2. extend this program as authorized through official notification from the granting agency in order to complete the goals of the program;
3. retain funds from the grant in an amount not to exceed the annually negotiated indirect cost rate, as allowed and approved by the FLDOE; and
4. direct Financial Operations to establish appropriations in the amounts approved or as amended by the granting agency; such appropriations to be reported periodically to the Board.
