The President of the Florida Senate and the Speaker of the Florida House of Representatives have announced a special session on the state budget deficit. The Special Session is tentatively scheduled for September 18th through early October, 2007, with committee meetings beginning late August, 2007. As you are aware, Florida's economy has slowed more than estimated; therefore, if this trend continues, state revenues would not support the current level of appropriations budgeted in the state's adopted General Appropriations Act of 2007.
