Authorization is requested to accept a grant award from the United States Department of Education (USDOE), in the total amount of \$1,739,378, to fund the Teaching American History program at Miami-Dade County Public Schools (M-DCPS) and to enter into separate contractual agreements with Edvantia for evaluation services totaling \$198,605, and with Florida International University (FIU) for educational services totaling \$359,115, for the grant period of August 27, 2007, through July 30, 2010. The purpose of this three-year grant is to provide 200 teachers of American history in 5th, 8th, and 11th grades with professional development at one of three levels of intensity – a Master Degree program, a workshop series or a lecture series – along with scholar-guided travel for high performers in each group. The grant will be managed by Curriculum and Instruction, Secondary Education, and supports the Superintendent's initiative to improve return on investment of grant dollars.

No matching funds are required as a condition to receive the grant funding. Grant funds will be used to fund one full-time Project Coordinator and one part-time Project Assistant with social studies expertise; equipment; out-of-county travel for grantee meetings required by funder; printing and supplies; textbooks; partial tuition for the Master Degree program; contracted services for professional development; teacher stipends; substitutes; and program evaluation.

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In accordance with the terms of the grant application, authorization is requested to enter into separate contractual agreements totaling \$557,720, as listed below, serving schools throughout the District with a concentration on schools that do not meet or probably will not meet Annual Yearly Progress as defined by the No Child Left Behind Act. These institutions will collaborate in the design, implementation and program evaluation of the professional development opportunities provided through this grant in order to meet the goal of increasing teacher knowledge of American history.

- accept a grant award from the United States Department of Education (USDOE) for the Teaching American History program in the total amount of \$1,739,378 (one lump sum) for the grant period of August 27, 2007, through July 30, 2010;
- 2. enter into separate contractual agreements for the grant period of August 27, 2007, through July 30, 2010, with:
- a. Florida International University, in the amount of \$359,115; and
- b. Edvantia, in the amount of \$198,605.
- retain funds from the grant in an amount not to exceed the annually negotiated indirect cost rate, as allowed and approved by the USDOE;
- 4. extend this program and contractual agreements as authorized through official notification from the granting agency in order to complete the goals of the program; and
- 5. direct Financial Operations to establish appropriations in the amounts approved or as amended by the granting agency; such appropriations to be reported periodically to the Board.
