Authorization is requested to accept a grant through a contract, in the approximate amount of \$166,561, with the City of Miami Gardens for funding Project Miami Partnership for Action in Communities (MPACT) for the grant period from February 1, 2007, to January 31, 2008. Project MPACT provides comprehensive intervention strategies to reduce dropout rates and to decrease negative behaviors that lead to youth gang violence. Project MPACT is managed by Miami-Dade Schools Police Department (M-DSPD) and supports the Education Compact with the City of Miami Gardens.

The City of Miami Gardens submitted a grant proposal to The Children's Trust, in collaboration with M-DSPD, Project MPACT, to expand activities of the Comprehensive On-the-Job Training (OJT) and Employment Intervention Model to include 50 youth. The OJT component, in partnership with local construction businesses, will teach introductory carpentry skills; in addition, academic and counseling services will be provided to assist the youth participants in avoiding gang involvement and gaining employment skills.

No matching funds are required as a condition to receive this grant funding. Funds will cover program supplies and contracted services. Indirect cost is not allowed.

Official notification of this grant award was received on June 29, 2007. Reimbursement of grant-related expenditures is authorized effective February 1, 2007.
