As required by Section 1001.452, F.5, Florida Statutes, every Miami-Dade County public school and educational center has created an Educational Excellence School Advisory Council (EESAC). The EESAC serves as the School-based governance structure through which stakeholders are involved in decisions pertaining to student achievement and school improvement initiatives. As such, the EESAC is responsible for preparing, monitoring, and reviewing the School Improvement Plan (SIP). Additional recommendations are made by the EESAC to the principal in the areas of budget preparation, training, instructional materials, technology, staffing, student support services, school safety, and discipline strategies.

The composition of the EESACs include the principal; the United Teachers of Dade designated steward; and, a balanced number of teachers, education support employees, students, parents, and business/community representatives. In addition, each EESAC must be representative of the ethnic, racial, and linguistic makeup, as well as the various exceptionalities and economic diversity, of the community served by the school. Also, a majority of its members must be persons not employed at the school. The rosters are updated throughout the year to fill vacancies. All requests for composition waivers are reviewed by the District EESAC Support Committee, convened as necessary by Labor Relations.
