In November 2002, Florida voters passed a constitutional amendment (Amendment 9) requiring school class sizes to be capped by the 2010 school year as follows:

Instructional Grade	Class Size
K-3	18
4-8	22
9-12	25

In response, the legislature created the Classrooms for Kids and Effort Recognition programs to fund the construction of student stations for this purpose. Please note the District's allocations from this program as compared to the funds appropriated statewide.

The current funding formula for capital Class Size Reduction funds is largely based on growth. Given that the District has recently been experiencing a decline in enrollment, MDCPS has received a disproportionate share (less than 5%) of the total statewide allocation for the past few years. A top priority in the District's legislative program is to revise the funding formula for capital Class Size Reduction funds to be based more on need rather than growth. To meet the State's class size mandate, the District needs more than \$600 million in capital outlay funding. Less than a quarter of the estimate has been funded by the state. As a result, the District has leveraged the Local Optional Millage Levy through the issuance of Certificates of Participation to meet the Class Size Reduction mandate.

The Office of Budget Management, in collaboration with Facilities, has completed the attached required FDOE certification and project allocation list for participation in the program.

RECOMMENDED:

That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, approve the submission of the required certification for the 2007-2008 appropriation for Classrooms for Kids Program and the project allocation list detailing the capital projects to be funded from this program.
