This emergency request was required to purchase epoxy flooring resurfacing services, at Hammocks Middle School, prior to the opening of school. The project consisted of resurfacing the existing epoxy coating located in three (3) main stairwells, during the summer recess period. Undertaking this project, with the student and staff populations present, would have made it difficult to complete this project, inasmuch as it would have required some disruption at the school site, because of the epoxy-resin application and curing time.

A new bid for epoxy flooring has been issued and is currently under evaluation. A recommendation for award will be presented to the Board at a future Board meeting.
