SUBJECT: THE SCHOOL BOARD OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA v. JORGE CISNEROS, DOAH CASE NO. 07-3266

On March 15, 2006, the School Board took action to suspend and initiate dismissal proceedings against Jorge Cisneros, a teacher with Miami-Dade County Public Schools based upon his conviction for vehicular homicide. Mr. Cisneros requested an administrative hearing. The parties agreed to stipulate to all material facts and to the entry of a Recommended Order based on the sole issue of whether Mr. Cisneros was convicted of a crime involving moral turpitude.

By Recommended Order entered on September 11, 2007, Administrative Law Judge Claude B. Arrington recommended that the School Board enter a final order terminating Mr. Cisneros' employment.

A copy of the Recommended Order is being furnished to the Board under separate cover, along with a copy of the proposed Final Order.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida enter a Final Order accepting the Administrative Law Judge's Recommended Order in the case of The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida v. Jorge Cisneros, DOAH Case No. 07-3266, terminating the employment of Jorge Cisneros, and denying any and all claims for backpay.
